JAZZ AUDITION REQUIREMENTS 2024

All jazz ensemble applicants must prepare the required solo for their respective instruments and play along the MP3 tracks.

JAZZ REQUIRED SCALES (Please note that we will NOT be using the modal scales)

Use the Revised Jazz scale sheets uploaded on the MMEA Audition website and scroll to the bottom.

JAZZ DRUMS

All jazz drum musicians will play 32 bars of time. They will do this in all five of the following styles at the given tempo:

- Medium Swing (quarter note = 152)
- Latin/Bossa Nova (quarter note = 136)
- Jazz Waltz (quarter note = 144)
- Jazz Funk/Rock Straight 8th's (quarter note = 100)
- Swing Trade 4's (quarter note = 180)

CONCERT WINDS, STRINGS, MALLETS, and VOCAL SCALE REQUIREMENTS 2024

All scale requirements will be in effect for the 2024 auditions. Scale sheets can be found on the <u>MMEA Audition</u> website by scrolling to the bottom. All scales are to be <u>MEMORIZED</u>.

SIGHT READING REQUIREMENTS 2024

Traditional sight-reading requirements will be used in a live audition setting.

SOLO REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS 2024

Students must learn all of the <u>assigned</u> movements for the audition. On the day of the audition, the adjudicator will choose from the assigned material. Cadenza sections will not be asked for any student.

MULTI PERCUSSION 2024

- All timpani, snare drum, and mallet musicians will be required to play 5 multi-percussion examples.
 - o Triangle
 - Tambourine
 - Crash Cymbals
 - Suspended Cymbals
 - o Bass Drum
- The Multi Percussion example can be downloaded from the <u>MMEA Audition website</u>.
- Musicians may pause slightly between each example.
