Jazz Band Audition Requirements:

Jazz Auditions:	Snidero – Grease, Jazz Conception, Advance Music. Students will be asked to perform solo with recording (minus soloist with rhythm section only). Drummers be sure to prepare the transcription, not the lead sheet. Students may transpose any portion of the melody either up or down one octave to accommodate range.
Jazz Improvisation:	Students will be asked to improvise over changes in Grease. IMPROVISATION IS NOT REQUIRED FOR AUDITION. Students will be assessed and given feedback in this area, however it will not be added into the final tabulation. Improvisation scores may be used to assist the director in assigning parts within the ensemble.
Guitar/bass/piano & vibes:	In addition to the written solo, students will comp changes from assigned solo. Be prepared to comp a standard blues progression and a ii V I progression in keys up to and including 3 sharps and 3 flats. Comping is described as performing in appropriate rhythmic style to the chord progressions, using a variety of jazz voicings of chords in the progression.
Jazz Drums:	In addition to the listed performance solo, drummers should prepare to play in a funk style, a swing style, and a bossa nova style. These styles should be demonstrated in the format of four bars of time followed immediately by a four bar solo. These pieces should demonstrate technical and musical control of the drum set.
